SUMMER SESSION JUNE 10, 2008 TO AUGUST 31, 2008

Early Childhood Education Programs at NCM serve children not yet of school age. Programs focus on two age groups: 2 and younger, and 3–5 year olds. These programs are offered year-round on a drop-in or advance purchase basis according to four seasonal sessions.

COST *for one caregiver and one child*

Visitors are welcome to attend classes on a drop-in basis or may place an advanced purchase for six classes at a discounted price.

Drop in rate:

\$20 public, includes Museum admission
\$10 members, includes Museum admission

Advance purchase:

\$100 public, for six sessions; includes Museum admission
\$50 members, for six sessions; includes Museum admission

Drop-in sibling rate:

\$16 public, includes Museum admission
\$8 member, includes Museum admission

Advance purchase sibling rate:

\$80 public, for six sessions, includes Museum admission
\$40 member, for six sessions, includes Museum admission

Please note: Advanced purchase includes 5 paid classes and 1 free class during the June 10, 2008–August 31, 2008 session. It does not include guaranteed or held spots in specific classes, as classes are on a first come, first serve basis.

MUSIC AND MOVEMENT

For children 0–2 years old

Tuesdays 10–10:45am, and Sundays 10:45–11:30am

The subject of Tuesday's class will be repeated on Sunday.

Description

This class will introduce and facilitate parent child interactions through the exploration of music by moving, singing, chanting rhythmic rhymes, and playing simple rhythmic instruments. The music used will be traditional children's songs suited to this young audience. The class will facilitate singing in tune and keeping a steady beat. Lyrics will be available on-line so that families can learn the words in advance of class time and/or extend the classroom experience at home.

BEATLES ROCK

For children 3–5 years old

Tuesdays 11–11:45 am, and Sundays 11:45am–12:30pm

The subject of Tuesday's class will be repeated on Sunday.

Description

What could be cooler than hipping your kids to some of the best pop music ever made? This class will have you and your child "Shake, Rattle and Roll"-ing to the music of the Beatles. Using kid friendly Beatles songs, Beatles Rock will help your youngster build basic rhythm and singing skills. Lyrics will be available on-line so that families can learn the words in advance of class time and/or extend the classroom experience at home. Beatles Rock will have your child moving, singing and wanting to "shake it some more".
