school tours

The New Children's Museum offers self-guided and facilitated hands-on tours for schools and mission-affiliated non-profit organizations. Groups will explore the exhibition with a focus on age-appropriate, curriculum based activities. Each tour includes an opportunity to make art in the studio spaces. Tours are offered every weekday with the exception of Wednesday, when the Museum is closed.

OPTIONS

► SELF-GUIDED TOURS

Self-guided tours are available during the morning session and are accompanied by curriculum to help teachers and chaperones engage and educate students.

Morning Session: 10-11:30am

Available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Price per child: \$5

Price per chaperone: The Museum requires 1 chaperone per 5 students for grades K-8 and 1 chaperone per every 10 students for high school. Chaperones are admitted for free at a ratio of up to 1 chaperone per every 3 students. Additional chaperones are \$5 each.

Children under 1 are free.

► FACILITATED TOURS

The Museum offers facilitated tours during the morning session. Facilitated tours will be led by a trained NCM guide.

Morning Session: 10-11:30am

Available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday

Price per child: \$5

Price per chaperone: The Museum requires 1 chaperone per 5 students for grades K-8 and 1 chaperone per every 10 students for high school. Chaperones are \$5 each.

Children under 1 are free.

► TITLE 1 SCHOOLS

The Museum offers self-guided tours for all Title 1 schools free of charge during the afternoon session.

Afternoon Session: 11:30am-1pm

Available Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday

OPTIONAL STUDIO ACTIVITY

School groups may choose to participate in an additional studio activity in our cutting edge Arts Education Center. This activity is inspired by the current exhibition and is led by one of our trained NCM artists. The optional studio activity is offered in the half hour following the morning or afternoon tour (11:30am–12pm or 1–1:30pm)

Optional studio activity fee: additional \$3 per child

IMPORTANT TIPS FOR ALL SCHOOL TOURS

Minimum Group Size: 10

Maximum Group Size: 60

Educators bringing a school group to the Museum are encouraged to take advantage of a free “pre-visit” to the Museum prior to their class visit. This will give educators the opportunity to become familiar with the Museum’s layout and current exhibition.

The Museum also encourages educators to review the age-appropriate, curriculum based, tour resources prior to their class visit. Educators use these points to guide their students through the Museum. The guide poses thinking questions and discussions about the art for students to ponder.

Cancellations must be made at least two weeks in advance to avoid being charged in full.
